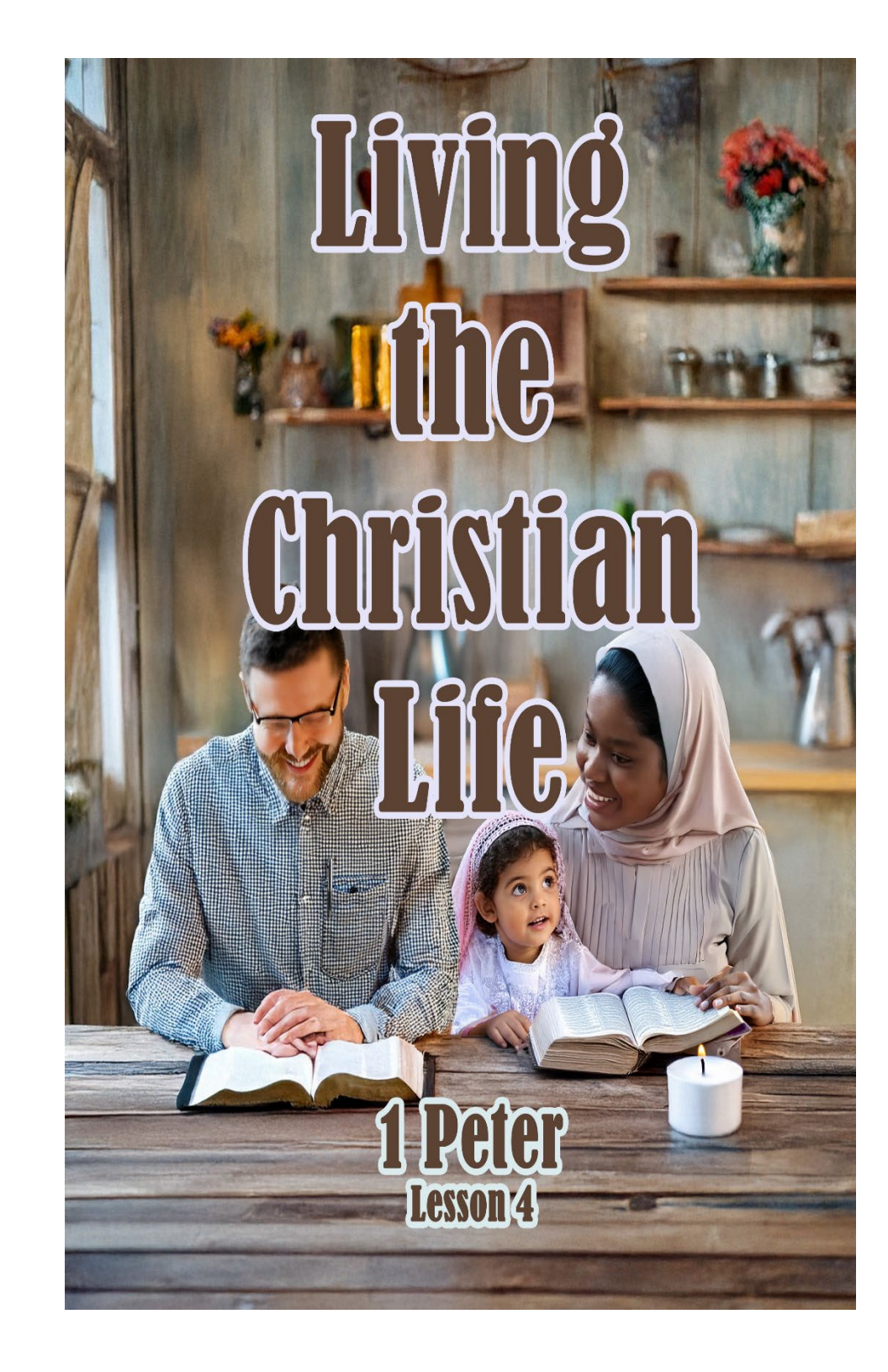

Living the Christian Life

Lesson 4 – I Peter 1:11-13



Read I Peter 1:11-13 before you continue reading. As you read, pay close attention to the sincere love of God and His people that radiates from Peter's writings!

REVIEW: I Peter 1:1-10 – Peter wrote to the “strangers”, which were the Jews and Gentile believers that were “not of this world”, who were scattered throughout the world. These “elect” were sanctified by the Spirit through their faith shown by their actions and the blood of Jesus that washed away their sins. They were “resurrected” to “new life” in Christ to a “living faith” to receive an eternal inheritance being “kept” by their faithfulness to God! They will be persecuted for their faith, but this trial of their faith is priceless “*being much more precious than of gold*”! The prophets foretold of this grace, but they did not completely understand what God has revealed to us through His Holy Spirit!

Verse 11-12 “*Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them [the prophets] did signify, when It [Holy Spirit] testified beforehand [the prophecies in the Old Testament of] the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. Unto whom [the prophets] it [suffering of Christ] was revealed, that not unto themselves [not to their benefit], but unto us [Christians] they did minister [instruct] the things [the prophecies], which are now reported [preached and taught] unto you by them [Apostles] that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.*”

The prophets desired to understand the prophecies that they spoke and wrote by way of the Holy Spirit within them. They wrote of the time in which God would fulfil His will for our redemption through the death of Jesus, so that every man ever born could be reunited to walk with God and receive the “glories” of eternal life with Him forever! These prophecies were not written just for their benefit, but for the benefit of all that through faith would receive the blessings of the gospel, which the Apostles now as eyewitnesses share with us through the Word of God! These blessings are so wonderful, that the angels of God desire to see them also!

God revealed His word to the faithful prophets of the Old Covenant, promising a New Covenant with the house of Israel, because Israel rejected His law. This covenant would include the giving of the Holy Spirit through the sacrifice of Christ to fulfil the law in the lives of those who would repent of their sins. God did not change, for this has been His plan from the beginning. God has always desired to walk or dwell with man. Jeremiah 31:31-34 teaches us,

*“Behold, the days come, saith the LORD,
that I will make a New Covenant with the house of Israel...
Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers...
which My covenant they brake... After those days, saith the LORD,
I will put **My law in their inward parts**, and write it in their hearts;
and will be their God, and they shall be My people.
And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour,
and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know Me,
from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD:
for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.”*

Jesus restored the world back to God by laying down His life for man, that we might have the choice to walk with God through faith in the gospel! Walking in the Spirit of God is the Christian Life! If you yield to the perfect will of God outlined in His gospel, God gives you the Holy Spirit to guide you into all truth!

Verse 13 *“Wherefore* [because you have the Holy Spirit] *gird up* [strengthen] *the loins* [the hips possess real strength] *of your mind* [thinking; imagination]...

Peter tells you that since you have been given the entire picture through the Spirit and you possess the complete Word of God [including all the prophecies and their fulfillment], you should strengthen your thinking in righteousness, so that **you think as God does**. Brainwashing is always thought of as unbelievably bad, but the Bible commands you to allow God and His Word to **wash your thinking**. Ephesians 5:26-27 says,

“That He might sanctify [separate] *and cleanse it* [the church] *with the washing of water by the WORD* [brainwashing],
That He might present it [the church] *to Himself a glorious church,*
NOT having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing [not defiled by the world];
but that it [the church] *should be holy and without blemish* [as He is holy].”

You need to wash your brain of all the programming of this world through philosophy, excuses, images, violence, self-will, and arrogance! As Adam should have done, you need to reject the tree of knowledge of good and evil and choose only to eat of the Tree of Life! Ephesians 6:14 teaches this also,

“Stand therefore [know the Truth and don't compromise],
having your loins [strength of your mind] *girt* [strengthened]
about with truth [God's Word],
and having on the breastplate of righteousness.”

Notice that you are to take a stand, which uses the power of your “loins” or hips as a parable. The “loins” or your hip section of your body is the “trunk” or strength of standing strong. The “loins” of your mind must be strong, so that you do not become weak in the faith. Peter knows that if you do not purpose in your mind that you will “stand” against sin, you will “give in” and compromise with satan and the world!

The “breastplate” is a piece of armour that protects your physical heart, but the “breastplate” of righteousness worn through faith in the truth protects your heart from the deception of satan! This breastplate of righteousness is very important to understand, for it guards us against the deception of sin as commanded in Ephesians 6:14,

*“Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth,
and having on the **breastplate of righteousness**.”*

The “loins” must have the “girdle” or belt of truth to strengthen our stand for God! Righteousness must be the desired end or purpose in our lives!

Isaiah 11:5 is a prophecy of Jesus, the Branch, which speaks of His strength to stand against the wickedness of this world.

*“And righteousness shall be the girdle [brace] of His loins,
and faithfulness the girdle [brace] of His reins [thinking].”*

This brainwashing is **from** the thinking of the world to the righteous and holy thinking of God. Therefore, those who watch television, videos, movies, YouTube, the internet, or other wicked forms of entertainment have already LOST THE BATTLE OF THEIR PURE MIND. Perhaps you think if you “guard” against nudity and cursing that you are alright, but the philosophy of the world has redefined right and wrong! Sifting through the sludge of entertainment reveals what is in your heart! It matters not what people’s opinion may be! God is holy and He expects you to guard your mind from the filthy thinking of the world.

When I was first converted [now over thirty-five years ago], I thought that there might be some movies or cartoons that the world produced that I could have a little family “entertainment” night. Satan was laughing at me as he sought to drag me back to his wicked grip of lust! As I looked at the various movies; I asked myself, “Will this cause me to obey the gospel and love the LORD with all my heart, soul, and mind? Will this cause me to think holy thoughts and glorify God?”

Well, that ruled out all the movies, all the children’s cartoons [full of violence, lying, sneaking, deceiving, and disrespect, etc.], all the movies about the “family” (no daddies, no family, and no Bible), all the modern shows or reruns [with no discipline, no prayer, no Jesus, and no Bible – very bad philosophy regarding child-rearing], and all the “Christian” movies.

I asked the Lord to forgive me, after seeing what sinful trash a Biblical story was turned into. Do not let Hollywood influence your pure thinking, and don't let ANY movie or video dictate to your children how they should think either. All of those cartoons have perverted philosophy that goes directly against the Bible and encourages seducing spirits. How do they help you to obey the gospel of "pure in heart"? They only pervert your mind to think as the god of this world, who is blinding the hearts and minds of all who are programmed by them!

*"Blessed are **the pure in heart**: for they shall see God."*

Matthew 5:8

How do they draw you closer to God or make you want to pray or read your Bible more? Where is contentment and self-denial taught? There is also no such thing as a "Christian movie", either! If you believe in "Christian movies", then you must also believe in Christian immorality and murder! All of these are made to entertain your mind right to hell! They create a "longing" for the things and comforts of this world that will never bring the peace that Jesus promised.

If you disagree about the entertainment of this world, then you must be honest with yourself... it's your sinful flesh that you do not want to put to death. You love the lust, violence, and seduction more than you love God and His holiness! You are in the flesh and are looking for every excuse you can to appear "Christian", but enjoy satan's pleasures of this world!

Romans 12:2 commands us,

*"And be not conformed [patterned after] to this world:
but be ye transformed [changed] by the renewing of your mind [God's Word],
that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."*

Jesus spoke of your thinking in Luke 12:34,

*"For where your treasure [love of pleasure] is [which begins in the mind],
there will your heart be also."*

Jesus again talks about the "loins" or hips being strengthened in verse 35,

"Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning."

Jesus is speaking of His coming for you... for you do not know what day, hour, or minute will be your last! He warns in verse 36,

*"And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord,
when He will return from the wedding; that when He cometh and knocketh,
they may open unto Him immediately."*

Every sin that is committed begins and is weighed in the mind. This is why Paul tells us in Romans 16:19,

"...I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil."

Those who partake in such wickedness show what is in their heart and who they are serving. Satan desires to entertain the world right into hell. The internet now spans the entire world, by which satan desires to control with his wicked thinking. Those professing to serve God must make a choice of whom they will serve as explained in Romans 6:16!

*“Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey,
his servants ye are to whom ye obey;
whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?”*

If you put worldliness, wrong philosophy, nudity, carnality, filthy talk, and covetousness into your mind; satan has eternally damned your soul! Isaiah 55:8 tells us that God does not think as we think; but we have the mind of Christ according to I Corinthians 2:16, which is found in His Word. It is your job to study (II Timothy 2:15) to show yourself approved unto God and to *“flee also youthful lusts”* (II Timothy 2:22).

HERE IS A VERY OLD QUOTE THAT YOU NEED TO READ TO REALLY UNDERSTAND WHAT IS GOING ON TODAY BY WAY OF THE INTERNET! Anton LaVey (head “pastor” of the **satanic church**) said this many years ago about television. Satan’s agenda was very small with the television, for now satan uses the “world wide web” or internet to destroy the entire world with his wicked thinking, yet those who “claim to be Christians” partake of his wicked indoctrination or brainwashing!

"Television is the major mainstream infiltration for the new satanic religion. The TV set or **satanic family altar** has grown more elaborate since the early '50s, from the tiny fuzzy screen to huge entertainment centers covering entire walls with several monitors. What started as **an innocent respite from everyday life** has become in itself **a replacement for real life for millions**, a major religion of the masses. All religions are coming around to satanism."

This open satanic leader boasts of the destructiveness of the “media”, yet those who call themselves Christians partake in satan’s internet today! The internet is the “world wide web”, by which the antichrist or “man of sin” will control the world and IS already!

As you get into the Word of God, your thinking and perspective changes as you read that you are **a stranger and pilgrim on this earth in I Peter 2:11**,

*“Dearly beloved, I beseech you as STRANGERS AND PILGRIMS,
abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul.”*

Knowing that you are “just passing through”, you also realize that your life is as a vapour [a mist of moisture] as James 4:14 teaches,

*“Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life?
IT IS EVEN A VAPOUR, THAT APPEARETH FOR A LITTLE TIME,
AND THEN VANISHETH AWAY.”*

A vapour is like steam or a mist in the air. It only lasts a very short time until it is consumed by the vastness of the universe. Knowing how short your life is, Jesus encourages you not to lay up treasures on this earth in Matthew 6:19-20,

***“Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth,
where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:
But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven,
where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt,
and where thieves do not break through nor steal.”***

What treasures can you lay up in Heaven? The treasures in Heaven are eternal life given to the faithful few who will deny themselves, take up their cross daily, and follow Jesus in His steps. We are commanded to always be abounding in the work of the Lord in I Corinthians 15:58, which causes us to lay up those treasures.

*“Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable,
always abounding in the work of the Lord,
forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.”*

You will receive the reward of the inheritance at the day of judgment according to your works. Every man will be judged by God, Who knows all things including your thoughts and motives. He will reward you for your labor in eternity as Colossians 3:24 teaches,

*“Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance:
for ye serve the Lord Christ.”*

Instead of fearing the circumstances and what will happen tomorrow, you must understand that God is in control of all things; which includes politics, jobs, families, and even your authorities' hearts. He puts the heathen in power for His perfect will's sake. You must learn to trust Him in everything without fearing man as Psalm 75:6-7 teaches,

*“For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west,
nor from the south. But God is the Judge:
He putteth down one, and setteth up another.”*

Though it appears in man's eyes that the authority in a country is “in control”, we know that the leader can only do what God allows him to do according to His will. As we just learned, God puts into power and takes out of power those rulers over us according to the punishment that He is going to bring upon the world. Though they appear to be very powerful as they unite against Him, we know the end of the world! God is in complete control!

*“The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water:
He turneth it whithersoever [however] He will [desires].”*
Proverbs 21:1

Since we are strangers and pilgrims in this world and our lives are but a vapour or mist, we must understand that everything that we do in this world has eternal blessings or curses. We must lay up for ourselves treasures in Heaven by always abounding in the work of the Lord, because He will reward us according to our labours in eternity. God is in complete control, no matter how powerful the governments of men may appear to us. He has a plan, and in the end, He will come to punish the world for their sins. If we are faithful to Him, we will reign with Him forever in the New Jerusalem!

Praise ye the LORD! Knowing all this changes our thinking about our everyday life on this earth. We now know that nothing in this world is as it seems. The entire world is only temporary, and all will be destroyed by the wrath of God!

Wrong thinking puts your dependency upon yourself and your accomplishments, and takes it away from complete dependency upon God! Looking at the world in the flesh, instead of knowing the truth in the Spirit will cause you to take your eyes off of Jesus! Jesus taught this in Matthew 6:25,

*“Therefore I say unto you, **Take no thought for your life**, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?”*

Let’s study what the “called out” believers are to be thinking about from Philippians 4:6-8: [This portion of Scripture is talking to the faithful in Christ that are poor in spirit, repentant, meek, hungering and thirsting after righteousness, merciful, pure in heart, and have denied themselves, taken up their cross, and followed the Lord leaving father, mother, wife, sons, daughters, etc.]

*“Be careful for nothing [Don’t be anxious; fear; worry];
but in every thing [every part of your life] by prayer and supplication
[by crying out to God in faith] with thanksgiving [contentment; thankful heart]
let your requests [prayer] be made known unto God.
And the peace of God [calmness; restfulness within],
which passeth all understanding [the world cannot understand],
shall keep [preserve] your hearts [feelings] and minds [perception of things]
through Christ Jesus...*

Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are:

1. **true** [no lie is of the truth, not deceitful], *whatsoever things are*
2. **honest** [pure in heart; sincere], *whatsoever things are*
3. **just** [holy], *whatsoever things are*
4. **pure** [innocent, modest, chaste], *whatsoever things are*
5. **lovely** [acceptable to God], *whatsoever things are*
6. **of good report** [faithfulness]; *if there be any*
7. **virtue** [righteousness], *and if there be any*
8. **praise** [that glorifies God], **think on these things.**”

These eight things are really questions, which you can ask yourself before deciding to waste your time thinking on a subject or partaking in something that will influence your mind... which is just about anything in this world. You won't understand or desire this thinking if you are consumed or concerned with the thinking of this world. If you desire to serve two masters, this will be offensive to you. Paul speaks to those who are not of this world and are seeking those things which are above as Colossians 3:1-2 commands,

*"If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above...
Set your affection on things above [true, honest, just, pure...],
not on things on the earth [lies, compromise, ungodly, immoral...]."*

Complete faith and trust in the Lord is taught in Proverbs 16:3,

*"Commit thy works unto the LORD, and **thy thoughts shall be established.**"*

Your works are what you are feeding your mind with, such as the people with which you associate, the places you go, the things to which you listen, and the images or pictures of which your brain takes a lasting "photocopy" to either help or haunt you the rest of your life. Close your eyes and almost anything that you have seen with your eyes can be displayed in the "movie screen" of the mind. Mind control is taught in Exodus 20:17, for coveting is done in the mind!

*"Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house,
thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant,
nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass,
nor any thing that is thy neighbour's."*

Looking upon immodestly dressed people [male or female] in tight form-fitting clothing causes sin to begin in the mind. Lusting over painted and flashy attired women will only cause you to commit adultery with them in your heart. To control these thoughts, do not allow the pictures to be placed in your head! For those who already have these pictures in their heads, II Corinthians 10:5 is a must!

*"Casting down imaginations [images and pictures],
and every high thing [proud, self-willed]
that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God [holiness, righteousness],
and bringing into captivity [capturing and refusing]
every thought to the obedience of Christ."*

You must replace these wrong thoughts with good thoughts. If you are honest with yourself [those truly wanting to obey the Lord], you will admit that unless you cast down these thoughts, your flesh will control your thinking which leads to sin!

Men must “cast down” their lustful thoughts or they will never be happy and contented with the woman that God gives them. Your wife should be the only naked body that you see. Why do you think there is so much divorce and immorality among supposed “Christians” (religious pretenders) today? No one is warning of improper thinking habits that begin with what you have already put in front of your eyes!

Wives must learn to be content with the “things” that they have. It is amazing how many pastors’ wives crave the things and comforts of this world so much that their husbands must compromise the truth in order to keep them happy. No one seems content today, for in America where there is prosperity, it does not seem to be enough. Foreigners lust after the “American Dream” as they begin to dress, act, and talk like the unhappy Americans that appear to have “everything”!

Paul has a lot to say about the thinking pattern of the mind of Christians, as Philippians 2:5 tells us to think as Christ did,

“Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus.”

Can you really picture Jesus sitting in front of the internet watching what’s on there? Paul goes on to say in Ephesians 4:23-24,

*“And be renewed in the spirit (mental disposition) of your mind;
And that ye put on the new man (new thinking, goals, purpose),
which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.”*

The renewing of your mind means the complete changing of what you used to desire to the things that are the will of God for you and your family. It is very easy to desire a comfortable life in this world, but the end thereof is the way of death. Our thinking must be renewed in the knowledge of the will of God as Colossians 3:10 teaches,

*“And have put on the new man, which is **renewed in knowledge**
after the image of Him [righteousness of God] that created him.”*

You are to think as the new man, who is created by God in righteousness and true holiness; and this is God’s holiness, not man’s opinion of holiness! If you do not see the importance of not looking upon anything that does not pass the eight-question test of Philippians 4:8, then you have hardened your heart to the things of God! This complete change of thinking changes every decision that you make and how you look at everything. The world is worthless, but walking with God is all that you think about!

One more verse on this subject is found in Psalms 101:3,

“I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes...”

This is a statement made by a godly man who understood that it would lead to wrong thinking!!!! This teaches us how dangerous the internet is, because it will be the tool that unites the world on the side of the “man of sin”! It already controls the world and the thinking of the majority of people who “can’t live without it”! It’s time to wake up and understand the schemes of the devil!

Verse 13 – Continued “...*Be sober*...”

This next command also has to do with the mind as ...*be sober*... (serious-minded) is a mental attitude towards the commandments of God. Soberness means “serious-minded” or not allowing the world to “intoxicate” your mind [like making you “drunk” in sin]. Being sober means that you are alert and looking out for the pitfalls of the devil as he tries to hinder, wound, tempt, and eventually devour [destroy] you as I Peter 5:8 tells us,

*“Be **sober**, be vigilant [watchful]; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour [consume].”*

Satan is very active using any means possible. Many times satan will get Christians sidetracked on a good thing that is not the will of God or that leads to wrongdoing. You must be sober and alert to these schemes of the devil and watch for them by always being in the center of God’s perfect will. How can we do this??? We can do this by knowing and studying God’s Word, so that He speaks to us and gives us direction and by praying without ceasing.

I Thessalonians 5:6 commands us to be alert and serious-minded, so that we do not fall asleep as those of this world sleep in deception.

*“Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but **let us watch and be sober.**”*

We are not of the night (evil), because we are of the day with the bright light of truth leading us on the strait and narrow way of the gospel. Verse 8 says,

“But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope [faith] of salvation.”

Being sober is commanded for everyone as Paul commanded preachers in I Timothy 3:2 (also Titus 1:7), “*A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober....*” And what about their wives? I Timothy 3:11 says,

*“Even so must their wives be grave [heavenly-minded], not slanderers, sober [serious-minded], **faithful in all things.**”*

The aged men are in Titus 2:2,

“That the aged men be sober [serious-minded], grave [heavenly-minded], temperate [self-controlled], sound in faith [teaching the truth], in charity [true love], in patience [faithful].”

The **aged women** [older in the faith] are to teach the young women as Titus 2:4 says,

“That they may teach the young women to be sober [serious-minded], to love their husbands [do what is best for them], to love their children.”

Today, the “older” woman doesn’t know anything godly to teach the younger woman, because they are so caught up in the world! Their careers and own life crowd out the righteous role that God ordained for them. How can a woman that is not submissive to her husband, cannot control her children, and is not serious about her relationship with God have anything to teach anyone else?

Then Paul included the young men in Titus 2:6,

“Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.”

It is very difficult for a young man to be sober or serious-minded when he is so double-minded or following older men that are double-minded. Most men lie and convince themselves that they are not going after the things of this world as they put on a spiritual appearance. You must be serious-minded regarding eternal life and the coming wrath of God. Young men think that they have all the time in the world and that their fleshly desires are more important than eternal life.

Peter explains another reason that you must be sober in I Peter 4:7,

“But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.”

The “man of sin” shall be revealed very shortly as all of “Christianity” is waiting for Jesus to return, so they think! You are warned that there will be a falling away or apostasy from the truth of the Bible as Christians depart from the faith and give heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils. These spirits fill the internet, television, social media, and pulpits of the “social club” churches preaching balance, prosperity, compromise, worldliness, ungodliness, ecumenicalism, no repentance, and no holiness. They encourage unity at the price of compromise with satan! Balance really meaning entanglement in the world, and prosperity really meaning loving the world! Remember that the “Truth divides” those who desire to serve God from those who only desire a “form of godliness” as Jesus taught us in Matthew 10:34,

*“Think not that I am come to send peace on earth:
I came not to send peace, but a sword.”*

Verse 13 – Continued *“...and hope [patiently endure] to the end for the grace [mercy of God] that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.”*

Peter encourages all to “hope” or endure with intense anticipation unto the end. This is the perseverance of the saints. We must faithfully obey the will of God until the day that we stand before Jesus to hear *“Well done, thou good and faithful servant.”*

Jesus gives a stern warning that should make us sober about our daily walk with Him in Luke 21:36,

*“Watch ye therefore, and pray always,
that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to
pass, and **to stand before the Son of man.**”*

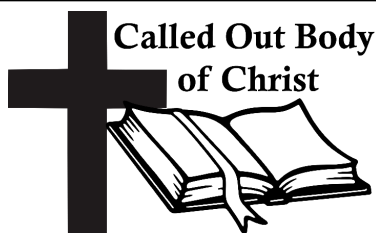
John encourages those who obey the gospel and are faithful of the love of God shown by calling us the sons of God. Upon His appearing, we shall eternally be like Him! While we are on this earth, we must continue to “grow in grace” by daily “purifying” ourselves from the lusts of the world! What a blessed hope that we have of eternal life. Read I John 3:3,

*“And every man that hath this hope in Him **purifieth himself,**
even as He is pure.”*

We have learned so much in this short lesson about how our thinking must be conformed to the thinking of God. It all starts as we realize that as Jesus is not of this world, so we are not of this world. We are pilgrims and strangers in this world, and all that is in this world is so very temporal.

We are tested daily to see if we love the Lord or this world! Do you not see that God has such eternal rewards for those who love Him with all their heart, soul, and mind much more than this world?

Let the mind of Christ from His word and the Holy Spirit within guide you into all truth as you purge yourself daily to be conformed to the image of Jesus!
